Important Notice:

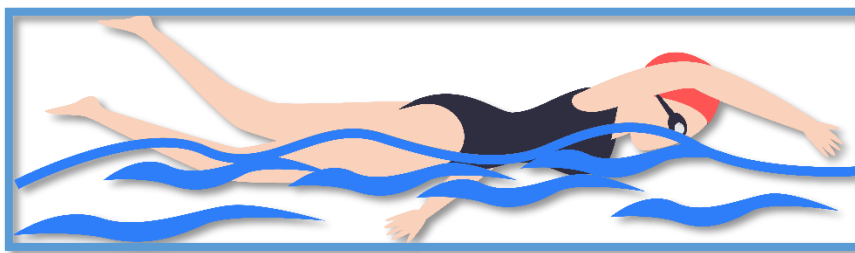




Swimming Lessons:

NEW PROCEDURES:

After half term, we will be continuing our new strategy to encourage all children to arrive in school on time. Our gate opens at **8.30am and closes at 8.45am**. We will ring the bell to indicate that the gate is closing. If you arrive after this time, you and/or your child **MUST** come into the school office to register and to choose their lunch choice. Your child will be marked late if they arrive after 8.45am and asked why they are absent unless you have specific permission from Mrs Doyle.

If your child arrives after the register has closed at 9.05am they will be marked as unauthorised absence which may result in a fine. Any absence that is unreported will also be marked as unauthorised.

If you need to take your child out of school during term time, please complete an absence request form in advance.

Any child who is absent from a session of school must have their absence recorded. This is a legal requirement from the Department of Education. Only the Head Teacher can authorise absence and if there is no known reason for the absence it will be recorded as unauthorised. The Head Teacher and Governing Body are accountable for attendance figures to the Department of Education.

Our learning this month:

Maple Class



Maple Class have enjoyed a wonderfully vibrant and enriching half term, filled with curiosity, creativity and a real sense of pride in their achievements. The children have embraced every learning opportunity with enthusiasm, making it a truly joyful few weeks.

A key highlight has been our work on significant people from history. The children have loved discovering the stories of remarkable individuals who helped shape the world. Through discussion, storytelling and creative activities, they developed a strong understanding of why these figures are remembered and celebrated.

In English, Maple Class have been fully immersed in our class text *The Hodgeheg*. They have delighted in exploring the characters' adventures and have used the story to strengthen their comprehension and writing skills. Their thoughtful ideas and lively discussions have brought our lessons to life.

In maths, the children have made fantastic progress. They have deepened their understanding of place value, become more confident when recognising and using coins and notes, and have been working hard to secure their addition and subtraction methods. Their growing accuracy and resilience have been wonderful to see.

Computing has taken us on an exciting journey as the children learned all about the International Space Station. They explored how astronauts live and work in space and were fascinated by the technology that makes life beyond Earth possible.

In PSHE, Maple Class have been learning about how to keep their bodies healthy. They have shown great maturity as they explored the choices they can make each day to support their wellbeing.

Our science topic has been all about animals and their habitats. The children have enjoyed investigating how different creatures are suited to their environments, learning about food chains and thinking about what animals need to survive. Their curiosity and thoughtful questions have made this a particularly engaging unit.

Forest School continues to be a weekly favourite. The children have shown wonderful teamwork, creativity and care for the natural world.

Maple Class should feel incredibly proud of everything they have achieved this half term. We look forward to even more exciting learning ahead.

Chestnut Class



As we come to the end of a very busy and successful term, we would like to take this opportunity to celebrate all of the children's hard work, enthusiasm and achievements across the curriculum.

In English, the children have thoroughly enjoyed exploring 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo and developing their reading skills through retrieval and inference activities. They have also shown great creativity and pride while planning, drafting and writing their own animal riddle texts and fact files. Through this work, the children have expanded their knowledge of animals and habitats whilst incorporating conjunctions, figurative language and ambitious vocabulary into their writing.

In Maths, the children have worked incredibly hard across a range of topics including short multiplication and division, related facts, formal written methods and measurement. More recently, we have focused on mass and capacity, exploring grams, kilograms and millilitres.

Our wider curriculum learning has also been full of exciting experiences. In History, we explored the achievements of Alfred the Great and continued learning about Viking settlements and their lasting legacy in England, including how Viking influence can still be seen in place names today. The children particularly enjoyed collaborating on research and presentations, demonstrating excellent teamwork skills.

In French, the children have grown in confidence using vocabulary linked to Petit Chaperon Rouge (Little Red Riding Hood), whilst RE lessons encouraged thoughtful discussion around myths.

Creativity has flourished in Art, where the children experimented with carbon paper techniques and pattern work, producing some wonderful outcomes.

Beyond the classroom, the children embraced opportunities such as swimming sessions, cricket and Dress Up Day, where they proudly arrived as their future ambitious selves. It was fantastic to see such a wide range of aspirations represented, including teachers, scientists, artists, chefs and vets.

We have also focused on Personal Development, celebrating individual talents and recognising one another's strengths, helping to build confidence and a positive classroom community.

Finally, we would like to thank families for their continued support with home learning, including IXL, Spelling Shed and TT Rock Stars practice.

We are incredibly proud of all the children have achieved this term. They have shown enthusiasm, resilience and a fantastic attitude towards learning throughout. We hope you all have a wonderful break and look forward to welcoming the children back refreshed and ready for another exciting term ahead.

These changes are aimed at making our shared spaces more pleasant for all students.



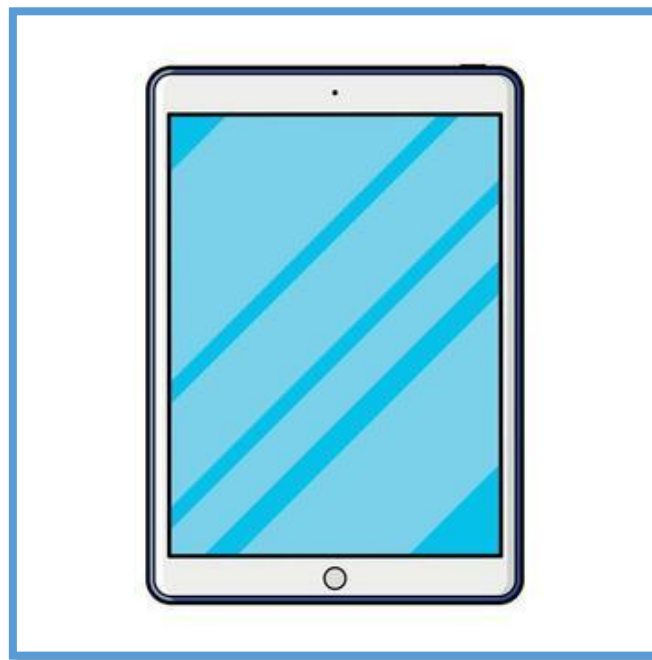


A generous donation to support our learners:

Kids and smartphones – what's the big deal?



Opportunity cost

More scrolling mean less time for play, movement, reading and real-life connection – the building blocks of a healthy childhood.



Harmful content

Extreme, explicit content is just a click away – often served by algorithms, even when kids aren't looking for it.



Mental health

Since smartphones became widespread, teen anxiety, depression and self-harm have surged. Early use is linked to poorer mental health.



Addiction

Apps are designed to hook kids in. The longer they scroll, the more money tech companies make – at any cost.



Attention

Smartphones hijack focus. Constant pings and notifications make it harder for kids to concentrate, learn, and enjoy deep focus.



Family life

Phones can quietly dominate home life – fuelling arguments, draining attention, and crowding out real connection between parents and kids.



Cyberbullying

Fallouts don't end at school anymore. They follow kids home, with no off switch and nowhere to escape the pressure.



Sleep

Blue light and late-night scrolling disrupt rest and recovery – leaving kids wired, overtired, and struggling to function the next day.



Grooming

Predators target kids on popular apps like TikTok and Snapchat – especially when they first get unsupervised smartphone access.
