Dear CSSG Member,

I am writing to inform you about some important changes that will impact how CSSG keeps in touch with you.

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) comes into effect on the 25th May 2018 and under this, CSSG is required to gain consent from you to confirm how you'd like us to communicate with you.

Keeping in touch with you enables us to keep you informed of all CSSG activity, such as meetings, events, and how you can support us.

We will continue to send out information to parents via the school email system, hard copies in school bags, notices in the school newsletter: none of these methods of communication require CSSG to hold or use parents' personal data.

Further information, such as minutes of meetings and reminders, may be provided on our Facebook page; by liking and following our page you are consenting to us using your Facebook contact details. Additional information is also, on occasion, emailed directly from cssgcontact@gmail.com or a class rep/committee member's personal e-mail address, if you have previously provided and given consent for CSSG to do so.


