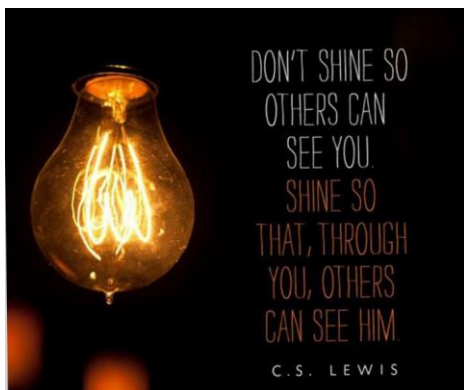
Please also do pop in and see your child’s class teacher, or put a note in their home diary, if you have any questions of concerns; staff are keen to continue to work together to promote the best for all children.
