## Some things at school will look a bit different.


Every day, I will come to school in clothing suitable for outdoor learning.  
I will not wear my school uniform.

I will bring in my school jumper or school cardigan on Monday.  
I will leave this in school, until I take it home to be washed on Friday.



Different groups of children will start the school day at different times  
and they will finish the school day at different times too.

I am in Year 6.



I will arrive at school at **9.00 am**.

I will be collected from school at **2.45 pm**.





**There is a new queuing system outside the school.**

Markers have been outlined on the pavement opposite the school.


When I am waiting to get into school, I will stand with my parent on one of these markers.

Standing on one of the markers will make sure there is a gap between me and the other parents.

**This is to keep everyone safe.**

When I arrive at school, I will walk up the ramp, making sure I stay on the markers and wait my turn.

When I leave school, I will walk down the stairs and be taken to my parent, who will be waiting at one of the markers.



## I will have my lessons in Sycamore Class.

I will get to Sycamore Class, in the usual way, by going up the stairs near the school office.



Whenever I need to leave Sycamore Class, for example to go to the toilet, I will use the stairs next to Yew Class.



Sycamore Class looks a little bit different because the desks have been spread out. There is a walkway that has been marked out in the centre of the classroom.



## Everyone has their own desk.

I will use the same desk each day. My desk has my name on it.



I will have my own pencil pot on my desk and my own tray under my desk, with my books inside.



I will keep my water bottle on my table and I will keep my lunch box under my desk, ready for me to get out at lunch time.

**I will eat lunch at my desk in my classroom.**






I will **not** have a peg.

When I bring a coat to school,  
it will go on the back of my chair.

The windows in the classroom will be kept open to  
make sure we have lots of fresh air.

We will also spend lots of time learning outdoors.



You will notice this zone marked on the classroom floor by the door.  
This is where other adults in the school will stand if they come to speak to us.



We have a first aid kit in our classroom, so I if I hurt myself  
I will be treated in my classroom not the school office.



## Going to the toilet will be a bit different too.



I will use the disabled toilet next to the school hall.  
This toilet is for Year 6 and key workers' children only.  
No other groups will use this toilet.

I cannot use the usual girls' and boys' toilets,  
as these will be used by other groups.



When I leave  
Sycamore Class to go  
to the toilet, I will go  
down the stairs next  
to Yew Class.



I can go into the toilet if the sign on the door is **green**.

**Green means go!**

When I go into the toilet, I will turn the sign to **red**.

**Red means stop!**

When I come out, I will change the sign to **green**.



When I walk through the hall to go to the toilet,  
I will stay within the corridor that has been  
marked out on the floor of the school hall.

When I return to the  
classroom, I will get to  
Sycamore Class, in the  
usual way, by going up  
the stairs near the  
school office.





I will play on the back playground for my break time and lunch time, with the other children in Year 6.

Children from other year groups will not go onto the back playground at the same time as us.

**We have our own equipment for PE.**

This will only be used by the children in Year 6.

It is kept in our classroom cupboard – only an adult can get the equipment.



If we are allowed to use a ball at lunch times, it will be a ball from our own equipment.

The equipment usually on the back playground cannot be used and has been covered.
